BACKGROUND CHECKS

It is the policy of Calvary Academy to require a standard background check on any individual desiring to help in the classroom, assist with a field trip, visit a class, or volunteer with students in any capacity. <u>Background check forms</u> can be found under Resources on our website. Please download and return to the Academy Office. Forms are also available in the Academy Office. Please note: once the background check is completed, it must be submitted to an outside agency for processing. This can take several days. A processed background check is required prior to assisting in the classroom or a field trip.

CALVARY ACADEMY APPAREL

CALVARY ACADEMY PE UNIFORMS

PE uniforms are required for students in 7th and 8th grades. PE Uniform items (shirt and shorts) are included in the online apparel shop. <u>Click to order.</u> Once the uniforms are received from the vendor and distributed, all students will be required to wear the uniforms for PE class. Students who are out of uniform in PE will receive a zero for the participation grade that day with an option offered to make up the zero in the next PE class. Each student is also allowed one no uniform pass.

CAMP CALVARY

DOLLAR DRESS DOWN DAYS

LOCKERS

All junior high and high school students are assigned a locker and have access to their lockers throughout the day. A lock can be provided by the student or requested via the Academy Office. Students may decorate only the inside of the lockers.

School lunch costs for 2023-2024 are as follows:

K5 - 8th grade \$3.00 | High School -\$3.50

If you would like to add lunches into your payments, as a convenience, you may do that. The following would be put on your child's lunch account to be used in the 2023-2024 school year: K5 -8th grade-\$515 | High School-\$600

MEDICAL DOCUMENTS

All students entering Pre-School, Jr. Kindergarten, Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades and students enrolling for the first time at Calvary Academy are required to have a current physical examination completed on the approved Illinois Department of Public Health Form. A sports physical does not meet the requirement. A current physical is one that was completed within one year of August 2023.

All students entering Kindergarten or enrolling for the first time at Calvary Academy must submit proof of a comprehensive eye exam by October 15, 2023.

All students in Kindergarten, 2nd grade, 6th grade, and 9th grade are required to submit proof of a dental examination by May 15, 2024.

The Illinois Missing Children Records Act (325 ILCS 50) requires submission of a certified copy of a child's birth certificate upon 30 days of enrollment. A copy of the certified birth certificate will be made by our office and the original returned to the parent as requested.

SAFETY & SECURITY

- All Calvary Church and Calvary Academy staff will wear a staff lanyard indicating they are staff. Calvary Academy Day Care staff now wear a shirt indicating they are day care staff.
- All students, parents, and visitors are asked to enter and exit the main entrance doors. Day Care families may
 still enter and exit the east day care entrance using their issued key fob. Reminder: please do not open any door
 for anyone else.
- All parents and visitors will be asked to sign in at the Main Entrance and will be provided with a lanyard indicating Visitor. Please return the lanyard to the Receptionist when leaving.
