#### JOIN US AT PARENT NIGHT!

Tuesday, August 18 is the first parent night for the 2015-2016 school year. 7th grade parents will meet in the Fellowship Hall at 6:00 p.m. and new Academy parents will meet in the Fellowship Hall at 6:30. There will be a general session for all parents in the Sanctuary starting at 7:00 p.m. This is a great opportunity for you to visit your child's classroom as well as get acquainted with their teachers. Be sure to register when you arrive to receive a \$50 credit toward your tuition for the school term.

# **Camp Calvary**

Camp Calvary is the before and after school care program for grades 1-6. If you are a new parent or a returning parent and would like to sign up, packets can be found in the Academy Office. Rates are as follows:

- \$50 per week for morning and afternoon care.
- A full week is considered three days or more; two days or less is considered half the rate.
- \$20 per week for the mornings only.
- \$30 per week for the afternoons only.

# JH/HS After School Policy

Calvary Academy will provide a teacher monitored after school study/social area for our junior high and high school students. If your child is in the building after 3:30 pm on a school day, they must report to the cafeteria and be picked up by 6:00 pm. Vending machines are available as well as a convenient view of the parking lot for pick up.

- 3:00 Elementary dismissal

- 3:10 JH/HS dismissal
- 3:20 Elementary students remaining will be directed to Camp Calvary. There is a charge for this service.

Students will be dropped off and picked up on the playground, weather permitting.

#### **Birth Certificates/Physicals**

Please remember to turn in an official birth certificate to the office if you have not already. Physicals are required for all new students entering CA, as well as 6th & 9th grade.

# **Graduation Requirement**

All high school students must complete 20 hours of community service each school year. These hours are in addition to NJHS/NHS service hours and financial aid hours. To help students complete this requirement, a year is from July 1st and ends on July 31st of the following year. Forms are available in the Academy Office.

## **Driver's Ed begins August 31**

Driver's Ed is offered to all 9th graders and above beginning on August 31 and ending October 30 in room 237 from 7:00-7:45 am. There is a signup sheet posted in the Academy Office.

### **Background Checks**

Any volunteer who wishes to work PIP hours must have a background check completed and on file in the Academy Office. Please note that all background checks expire after 3 years. Forms are available in the office.

# **Empowering Parents**

Calvary Academy offers parents numerous ways to lower their tuition throughout the school year and in the summer. Don't forget the following opportunities:

The Parent Involvement Program grants families \$10 of tuition credit for each hour volunteered up to a maximum of 20 hours per school year per family.

You can earn tuition credit of \$100 by simply attending 2 parent nights during the 14-15 school year or \$50 per night (maximum of 2 events).

If a new family enrolls at CA and uses your name as the referring party, your account will be credited 10% of the tuition the new family pays. Credit is applied in December and June and 5% each following year both families remain at CA.

Purchase Saints Savings to do your grocery, restaurant, gas station, retail shopping and gift giving (see enclosed listing of available cards) and CA splits the % of profit toward your account.

Walk-a-thon - 90% raised after the first \$25 (1 student) \$40 (more than one student) will be applied toward tuition.

Two product fundraisers net a minimum of 30% of your gross sale. This 30% is applied to your tuition account.

Candy bars are available for personal sales 12 months a year. For each box sold your profit is \$21.
