Welcome BACK TO SCHOOL

First day of school is Monday, August 19.

School hours are:

8:15 Warning bell

- 8:20 School begins (including pre-school class)
- 3:00 Elementary dismissal Camp Calvary students go directly to Camp Calvary.
- 3:10 JH/HS dismissal After school study/social area for JH/HS students in the cafeteria.
- 3:20 Elementary students remaining will be directed to Camp Calvary. There is a charge for this service.

*Please feel free to escort your elementary student(s) to their classrooms on the first day. Typically, students should be dropped off and picked up on the playground, weather permitting. After school, if weather is a factor, there will be a sign in the front window indicating playground or inside dismissal.



The State of Illinois requires students in these grades to present proof of having received a dental exam before May 15th of the school year. If you need a dental form, they are available in the Academy Office.

Calvary Academy Empowering Parents

Calvary Academy offers parents numerous ways to lower their tuition throughout the school year and in the summer. Don't forget the following opportunities:

The <u>Parent Involvement Program</u> grants families \$10 of tuition credit for each hour volunteered up to a maximum of 20 hours per school year per family.

You can earn tuition credit of \$100 by simply attending 2 parent nights during the school year or \$50 per night (maximum of 2 events).

If a new family enrolls at CA and uses your name as the referring party, your account will be credited 10% of the tuition the new family pays. Credit is applied in December and June and 5% each following year both families remain at CA.

Purchase Saints Savings to do your grocery, restaurant, gas station, retail shopping and gift giving (see enclosed listing of available cards) and CA credits 50% of profit toward your account.

Walk-a-thon - 90% raised after the first \$25 (1 student) \$40 (more than one student) will be applied toward tuition.

Two product fundraisers net a minimum of 30% of your gross sale. This 30% is applied to your tuition account.

Candy bars are available for personal sales 12 months a year. Your profit is \$24 for each box sold.

Free and Reduced Lunch Program

Camp Calvary

Camp Calvary is offered before & after school for any student in 1st - 6th grade. Morning hours are from 7AM - 8AM with cold breakfast served at approximately 7:30AM. After school hours are from 3PM - 6PM with a snack served at 4PM. Any student who has not been picked up by 3:20PM will be checked in to Camp Calvary. If you are a new parent or a returning parent and would like to sign up, packets can be found in the Academy Office. Rates are as follows:

- \$60 per week for morning and afternoon care.
- \$25 per week for the mornings only.
- \$35 per week for the afternoons only.

JH/HS After School Policy

Calvary Academy will provide a teacher monitored after school study/social area for our junior high and high school students. If your child is in the building after 3:30PM on a school day, they must report to the cafeteria and be picked up by 6:00PM. Permission for a student to leave the campus to walk to a local business, such as the gas station next door, must be sent in writing by a parent/guardian at the beginning of each school year. Vending machines are available as well as a convenient view of the parking lot for pick up.

Morning/Afternoon Drop-off and Pick-up

Please enter the east side driveway (by Oasis Building) off Jefferson Street to drop-off or pick-up at the playground and proceed to exit the west side drive way either to Bruns Lane or Jefferson Street. All JH/HS student drop-off and pick-up must be in the front of the building. Please observe the FRONT/BACK sign in the front window for the afternoon pick-up. Parents needing to get out of their cars must park in a parking space. **Parking in the fire lanes in front of the building is prohibited.**
