HEALTH & SAFETY

In accordance with the 30-day mandate by Governor Pritzker on August 4, 2021, all teachers, students, staff and visitors are required to wear a mask during school. We want our students in school and that is our priority. We are asking for parents and guardians to partner with us as we work to keep our students in school. Please provide a mask for you student daily.

Daily symptom screening will no longer be conducted on-site but we encourage all staff and students to do their own checks and stay home if not feeling well.

Social distancing of 3 feet or greater will be used to the extent possible. We will continue to execute concentrated cleaning and sanitation efforts throughout the day and educate and encourage proper hand hygiene. Medical quality air purifiers have been purchased & installed in each classroom. Water fountains will not be used. We encourage all students to bring a filled water bottle to school each day. Water bottles may be carried with the students throughout the day. A refill stations are available throughout the school.

MEDICAL DOCUMENTS

All students entering Pre-School, Jr. Kindergarten, Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades and students enrolling for the first time at Calvary Academy are required to have a current physical examination completed on the approved Illinois Department of Public Health Form. A sports physical does not meet the requirement. A current physical is one that was completed within one year of August 2021.

All students entering Kindergarten or enrolling for the first time at Calvary Academy must submit proof of a comprehensive eye exam by October 15, 2021.

All students in Kindergarten, 2nd grade, 6th grade, and 9th grade are required to submit proof of a dental examination by May 15, 2022.

Within 30 days of the first day of school, all parents must provide a certified copy of their student's birth certificate. A copy of the certified birth certificate will be made by our office and the original returned to the parent as requested.

UNIFORMS

School uniforms are required for students enrolled in Jr. Kindergarten through 8th grade. No uniforms are required for high school students but they must follow *dress code rules as outlined on our website*.

PE Uniforms are required for students in 7th and 8th grades. The online PE uniform shop has closed. Once the uniforms are received from the vendor and products are distributed, all students will be required to wear the uniforms for PE class. Students who are out of uniform in PE will receive a zero for the participation grade that day with an option offered by Coach Harnacke to make up the zero in the next PE class. Each student is also allowed one no uniform pass. The Academy Office has a limited supply of uniform apparel available for purchase.
