BACKGROUND CHECKS

It is the policy of Calvary Academy to require a standard background check on any individual desiring to help in the classroom, assist with a field trip, visit a class, or volunteer with students in any capacity. <u>Background check forms</u> can be found under Resources on our website. Please download and return to the Academy Office. Forms are also available in the Academy Office. Please note: once the background check is completed, it must be submitted to an outside agency for processing. This can take several days. A processed background check is required prior to assisting in the classroom or a field trip.

CALVARY ACADEMY APPAREL

Calvary Academy Online Apparel shop is open through midnight on Sunday, August 14. All apparel is uniform approved. Apparel is expected to arrive approximately two weeks after the shop closes. <u>View all options and place your order online</u>.

CALVARY ACADEMY PE UNIFORMS

PE uniforms are required for students in 7th and 8th grades. <u>The online PE uniform shop is now open.</u> Once the uniforms are received from the vendor and products are distributed, all students will be required to wear the uniforms for PE class. Students who are out of uniform in PE will receive a zero for the participation grade that day with an option offered by Coach Harnacke to make up the zero in the next PE class. Each student is also allowed one no uniform pass. The Academy Office has a limited supply of uniform apparel available for purchase.

CAMP CALVARY

Camp Calvary is our before and after school program for students enrolled in 1st – 6th grades. Morning hours: 7:00am – 8:00 with cold breakfast served at approximately 7:30am. DOLLAR DRESS DOWN DAYS

Every Friday will be a "Dollar Dress Down Day." Students may choose to pay a dollar to wear an expanded selection of clothing items. ILLINOIS STATE SALES TAX HOLIDAY

Public Act (P.A.) 102-0700 creates a state sales tax holiday on qualifying items effective August 5, 2022, through August 14, 2022. The state sales tax holiday is a ten-day period during which consumers can purchase certain clothing and school-related items and pay sales tax at a reduced rate. The state's portion of sales tax due throughout the holiday is reduced by 5 percent (5.00%) from 6.25 percent (6.25%) to 1.25 percent (1.25%).

LOCKERS

All junior high and high school students are assigned a locker and have access to their lockers throughout the day. A lock can be provided by the student or requested via the Academy Office. Students may decorate only the inside of the lockers.

LUNCH UPDATE

The Illinois State Board of Education has announced the end of the program offered during the pandemic that allowed for all students to receive a free school lunch. Calvary Academy will again be participating in the National School Lunch Program which allows for Free Lunch or Reduced Lunch (.40) for qualifying families. School lunch costs for 2022-2023 are as follows: K5 - 8th grade \$3.00 I High School -\$3.50

If you would like to add lunches into your payments, as a convenience, you may do that. The following would be put on your child's lunch account to be used in the 2022-2023 school year: K5 -8th grade-\$515 | High School-\$600

MEDICAL DOCUMENTS

All students entering Pre-School, Jr. Kindergarten, Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades and students enrolling for the first time at Calvary Academy are required to have a current physical examination completed on the approved Illinois Department of Public Health Form. A sports physical does not meet the requirement. A current physical is one that was completed within one year of August 2022.

All students entering Kindergarten or enrolling for the first time at Calvary Academy must submit proof of a comprehensive eye exam by October 15, 2022.

All students in Kindergarten, 2nd grade, 6th grade, and 9th grade are required to submit proof of a dental examination by May 15, 2023.

The Illinois Missing Children Records Act (325 ILCS 50) requires submission of a certified copy of a child's birth certificate upon 30 days of enrollment. A copy of the certified birth certificate will be made by our office and the original returned to the parent as requested.
