ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

New to Calvary Academy?

We know the first few days can feel overwhelming! Staff members will be outside each morning and afternoon to direct traffic, answer questions, and help your family find the correct drop-off and pick-up locations.

To help ensure the safety of our students and keep traffic flowing smoothly, please review the following arrival and dismissal procedures. We appreciate your patience and cooperation, especially during the first few weeks of school.

Early Arrival & Late Pick-Up

Elementary students should **not arrive before 7:55am** unless they are participating in a teacher-approved help session, athletic practice, or another school-approved activity.

Elementary students should be picked up **no later than 3:30pm** each day.

If your elementary student needs supervision before 7:55am or after 3:30pm, enrollment is required in one of the following programs:

- **Calvary Day Care:** Preschool, Jr. Kindergarten, and Kindergarten
- **Camp Calvary:** 1st–5th Grades

Junior High and High School Students may arrive as early as **7:30am**. Before school and after dismissal, students are to report to the cafeteria, where adult supervision is provided until **5:30pm**.

Morning Drop-Off

Students should be dropped off at the **front entrance** of the Academy and enter only through the doors marked **ENTRANCE**.

- Follow the designated drop-off lane.
- Pull forward as far as possible before stopping.
- Approach the entrance with the **passenger side of your vehicle facing the building**.
- Remain patient and cautious as students enter the building.

If you would like to walk your student into school, please park in a designated parking space before entering the building. When weather permits, elementary students may be dropped off at the supervised playground beginning at **8:00am**.

Afternoon Dismissal

Please approach the pickup lane with the **passenger side of your vehicle facing the building**.

- **Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd Grades :** Dismissal begins at **3:00pm** at the Academy front entrance.
- **3rd, 4th & 5th Grades:** Dismissal begins at **3:00pm** on the playground.

During inclement weather, students will be dismissed from the **back hallway door**, located east of the playground.

Families with Multiple Elementary Students

To simplify dismissal, families with children in multiple elementary grades will pick up **all elementary students at the location of the oldest sibling**.

Junior High & High School

- Students are dismissed at **3:10pm**.
- Parents should **park in a designated parking space** in the front parking lot and wait for their student
- **Please do not wait in the elementary pickup lanes for Junior High or High School students.** Keeping these lanes clear allows younger students to be dismissed safely and efficiently.

ATHLETICS

Sports Physicals. All students who wish to participate in any sport must have an updated physical on file in the Academy Office **before participating in practices or games**. Reminder: Physicals are valid for 395 days. If you are unsure whether your student needs an updated physical, please contact the Academy Office.

Athletic Agreement Signature Form. All parents and students must review the Student-Parent Athletic Handbook found on the CA Athletics website linked above. The Athletic Agreement Signature Form, located at the bottom of the CA Athletics website, must be completed before the first practice of the sport in which your student wishes to participate. An agreement only needs to be signed once per school year, even if students participate in multiple sports. A \$50 athletic fee is required for participation.

BACKGROUND CHECKS

Calvary Academy requires a standard background check for any individual wishing to help in the classroom, assist with a field trip, visit a class, or volunteer with students in any capacity. [Background check forms](#) are available under Resources on our website or in the Academy Office. Please complete and return the form to the Academy Office. Once the background check is completed, it must be submitted to an outside agency for processing. A processed background check must be on file before assisting in classrooms or on field trips.

CALVARY ACADEMY APPAREL

CALVARY ACADEMY PE UNIFORMS

PE uniforms are required for students in 6th, 7th and 8th grades. PE uniform items (shirt and shorts) are available via the [online apparel shop](#). Once uniforms are received from the vendor and distributed, students will be required to wear the PE uniform for class. Students who are out of uniform for PE will receive a zero for the participation grade that day, with the opportunity to make up the grade during the next PE class. Each student is allowed one no-uniform pass.

CAMP CALVARY

CALVARY DAY CARE

If your student already attends Calvary Day Care, you do not need to do anything further. New CA students in Pre-school, Jr. Kindergarten, or Kindergarten are allowed to begin childcare on the first day of school, **Monday, August 24**. DOLLAR DRESS DOWN DAYS

Every Friday will be a "Dollar Dress Down Day." Students may choose to pay a dollar to wear an expanded selection of clothing items. FACTS

The FACTS system is used to communicate grades and behavior reports for students. The daily announcements, athletic updates, lunch menu, and calendar events can also be found on FACTS family portal.

LOCKERS

All junior high and high school students are assigned a locker and have access to their lockers throughout the day. A lock can be provided by the student or requested via the Academy Office. Students may decorate only the inside of the lockers.

LUNCH

Calvary Academy participates in the National School Lunch Program which allows for Free Lunch or Reduced Lunch (.40) if you qualify. School lunch costs for 2026-2027 are as follows: K5 - 8th grade \$3.50 | High School \$4.00

Lunches are tracked electronically. Lunch charges are billed twice a month through Facts Mgt. Parents will receive an email/notification via Facts of all charges. The invoice is due within ten days and can be paid online or will be processed as an automatic ACH draft when due. Lunches can be pre-paid through your Facts account. MEDICAL DOCUMENTS

All students entering Pre-School, Jr. Kindergarten, Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades, and students enrolling for the first time at Calvary Academy are required to have a current physical examination completed on the approved Illinois Department of Public Health Form. A sports physical does not meet the requirement. A current physical is one that was completed within one year of August 2026.

All students entering Kindergarten or enrolling for the first time at Calvary Academy must submit proof of a comprehensive eye exam by October 15, 2026.

All students in Kindergarten, 2nd grade, 6th grade are required to submit proof of a dental examination by May 15, 2027.

The Illinois Missing Children Records Act (325 ILCS 50) requires submission of a certified copy of a child's birth certificate upon 30 days of enrollment. A copy of the certified birth certificate will be made by our office and the original returned to the parent as requested.

SAFETY & SECURITY

The safety of our students, families, staff, and visitors is a top priority at Calvary Church, Calvary Academy, and Calvary Day Care. We continually evaluate our safety procedures and make improvements as needed to help provide a secure learning environment.

The following procedures are in effect during school hours (Monday–Friday, 8:15am–3:30pm). We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain a safe campus.

Campus Access

- All students, parents, and visitors should enter and exit through the Main Entrance.
- Calvary Day Care families may continue to use the east Day Care entrance with their issued key fob.
- For everyone's safety, please do not open or hold exterior doors for others. Each visitor must enter through the appropriate entrance.

Visitor Check-In

- All parents and visitors must check in at the Main Entrance upon arrival.
- Visitors will receive a Visitor lanyard that must be worn while on campus.
- Please return the visitor lanyard to the receptionist before leaving.

Staff Identification

All Calvary Church, Calvary Academy, and Calvary Day Care staff members wear a staff lanyard or approved staff apparel so they can be easily identified.

If you notice anything that seems unusual or concerning while on campus, please notify a staff member immediately. We value your partnership in helping us provide a safe environment for every student and family.

STUDENT HANDBOOK UPDATES

As we begin the 2026–2027 school year, we encourage all families to review the updated Calvary Academy Student Handbook. Several policies have been clarified and revised to provide clearer expectations, greater consistency, and a positive learning environment that supports both students and teachers.

These updates are the result of thoughtful review by school leadership and the School Board and were informed by faculty input, observations throughout the previous school year, and feedback received through the parent surveys conducted at the conclusion of the 2025–2026 school year. We are grateful for the partnership of our families and appreciate the valuable insights you shared.

Our goal is not simply to add policies, but to establish clear, consistent expectations that support a well-structured, Christ-centered school culture where students can learn, grow, and thrive.

Highlights of the 2026–2027 Handbook Updates

Classroom Discipline (Grades 6–12)

A revised progressive discipline process establishes consistent classroom expectations while emphasizing opportunities for correction, accountability, and student growth.

Uniform & Dress Code

Dress code expectations have been updated to provide greater clarity and consistency. Please take the time to review the appropriate uniform and dress code for your student. [Dress Code | Calvary Academy \(caspringfield.org\)](#)

High School: Dress code standards have been clarified to make expectations more objective and consistently enforceable.

Kindergarten–8th Grade: Students may now wear **solid-colored** sweatshirts, hooded sweatshirts, cardigans, sweaters, and quarter-zip pullovers in **red, navy, or white only** during the school day. These garments must be worn over a dress code-compliant uniform shirt. Girls may also wear **solid-colored leggings in school colors or black** under uniform approved skirts.

Outerwear that does not meet these requirements may still be worn during recess and other outdoor activities but should not be worn in classrooms during instructional time.

Cell Phones & Personal Electronic Devices

One of the most significant updates for this school year is our revised cell phone policy, designed to reduce distractions, improve academic focus, encourage face-to-face interaction, and allow teachers to devote more attention to instruction and discipleship.

- **Kindergarten–5th Grade:** Students may bring a cell phone or personal electronic device to school; however, it must be turned off and turned in to the classroom teacher upon arrival. It will remain with the teacher until dismissal.
- **Grades 6–12:** Students may bring a cell phone to school, but it must be placed in the teacher's designated storage location at the beginning of each class period. Phones may not remain on a student's person during class and may only be accessed during passing periods and lunch.

Drug Testing Policy

The handbook includes updated language clarifying testing procedures, student responsibilities, consequences, and the school's response to the possession or distribution of drugs or alcohol.

Off-Campus Lunch (Seniors Only)

Eligibility requirements, expectations, and accountability for senior off-campus lunch privileges have been clarified while reinforcing Calvary Academy's closed-campus policy for all other grade levels.
